<sup>1</sup> Beginning with the 2016-17 academic year, Miami implemented the Miami Tuition Promise. Miami's Tuition Promise provides all first-time undergraduate students the certainty that tuition, room and board, special purpose fees and course fees will not increase over the four academic years of their Miami experience. The Tuition Promise does not apply to undergraduates who were enrolled prior to 2016-17.

The average tuition and general fees are based on the weighted average of students who are paying the Tuition Promise rates and students who are paying the non-Tuition Promise rates. The weighted average reported here matches the average tuition and fees reported to IPEDS.

<sup>2</sup> Increase in instructional fee of \$200.64 per semester for 2009-10 was waived for fall 2009 and spring 2010 semesters for Ohio residents. For fall and spring semesters, instructional fees were \$9,721, resulting in a total of \$11,443 in fees (0% increase from 2008-09).

<sup>3</sup> From the 2003-2004 through the 2007-2008 academic year, Miami University used a tuition structure that is not easily comparable with other years.
